GLOBAL COMMUNITY IRATE AT VINDICTIVE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT

PETITIONS DEMAND ONTARIO POLICE DETECTIVES AND CHILD PROTECTION AUTHORITIES BE SACKED

The global community continues to become more and more irate with the police, child protection system, courts and governments of Canada for their continued roles in the manhunt and malicious prosecution of Alex, Paige and Clayton Misener.

Calling for Change

Friends of Alex and Paige, in partnership with Change.Org, have launched two online petitions as part of our ongoing public awareness campaign.

Over five hundred signatures have been collected demanding that two police detectives and two social workers from Ontario be sacked due to their negligence and malicious prosecution in this horrifying case. Detective Sergeant Dennis Osti of the Niagara Regional Police Service, Detective Constable Ashley Horton of the Ontario Provincial Police, and Vanessa Pollock and Sarah Milmine of Family and Children's Services Niagara have lost the confidence and trust of the public, and people are calling for their resignation. This petition will be delivered to their respective leadership soon; however, it will remain online and continue to gather more signatures, updates sent periodically as a reminder.

Well over seven hundred signatures have been collected in a second petition demanding the Governments of Canada and Ontario cease their vindictive and malicious treatment of Alex, Paige and Clayton Misener, and that a public inquiry be called. The punitive actions of these governments has led to unbearable and intolerable circumstances for the family, including torture at the hands of a foreign government. This petition will be delivered to Justin Trudeau,

the Prime Minister of Canada, and other government officials. It too will remain online for others to sign in solidarity.

Awareness into Action

Support for the girls has really started to spring up in pockets around the world. In Germany, a group of Friends have initiated a boycott of Canadian as well as French products in their community, and we are expecting other similar initiatives. In the United States, Friends have cancelled business trips and vacations to Canada and France over concerns for the safety of their children. We are working to resolve technical challenges so we can take interviews on US media. Friends in Australia are also working hard to bolster awareness. We have now had contact with over forty thousand people worldwide through various social media channels and e-mail.

Litigation & Secret Tribunals

December is fast approaching and the family is eagerly anticipating their first day in court, advancing their lawsuit against the Canadian entities responsible for their exile, global manhunt, malicious prosecution and torture. We can confirm that negotiations are being attempted with two of the named parties; however, no agreements have been reached at this time. The list of adverse parties remains the same.

Alarming, absent from the conversation are the Attorneys General for Canada and Ontario, arguably the most culpable of the lot.

The Canadian courts continue to hold secret hearings without notice or disclosure to the family, precluding their participation. Several judges are aware of this practice, yet they continue to systematically violate the family's charter rights and refuse to allow them legal counsel. In the coming months, Friends will be exposing this for the world to see.

Important Information

The Facebook group Friends of Alex and Paige continues to enjoy a solid and dedicated membership, including former teachers, social service workers, experienced industry professionals and long-time members of the community. Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and

Justice Minister David Lametti have both been invited into the group, but neither has accepted that invitation to date.

We have changed our online banners to a sketch made by Alex expressing her experience at the hands of Jason Whittington and Kelly Campbell. Pictures like this were presented by the Chief Expert Child Psychologist of the French Supreme Court to evidence why the girls should have no contact whatsoever with their abusers, that they are safe with their father, Clayton, and should remain so.

Paige has been working on a haunting streamed video with Friends that will be published on various social media channels, expressing her views on her experience. The video is in the production stage at this time and promises to be shocking. We hope that the responsible parties will watch it and take a much different approach toward the family.

The European Union Commission on Human Rights as well as the United Nations High Commission on Refugees are being continually updated on this case, and we have attracted the attention of several senior government leaders in different E.U. countries, all watching with great concern. The family has reached out to several European countries in hopes that one of them may be willing to assume their asylum case against Canada, given the totality their treatment and malicious prosecution.

Investigations

Our investigation into the role news media has played in this debacle continues. Eight legacy news organizations have been identified to date as having printed and/or broadcast untrue statements about the family. The investigation continues.

Our investigation into corruption in the French justice system has, to date, led to the identification of nine individuals who have either broken French law, international law, and/or their own government policy. We now have in our hot little hands copies of diplomatic cables (secret messages) between Canada and France and intend to publish when the time is right.

Both of these investigations may lead to civil and/or criminal prosecutions under a separate cover. Please Help the Girls

Regardless of all the good that seems to be happening, the family is still in danger of being forcibly sent back to Canada, separated by police, imprisoned and, eventually, tried for their crime of seeking safety from abuse. We can not let this happen. The only people who can correct this situation are the Attorneys General of Canada and Ontario, and we wait for them to

come to the table.
